SINGAPORE >> REYKJAVIK Day 1

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and take-off to Reykjavik.

Day 2 **REYKJAVIK**

(Meals On Board/Hotel Dinner) Day 6

Upon arrival transfer to your hotel and spend the rest of the day at

*For mid Oct-Mar (Winter) departures-

This evening, you may wish to participate in an optional Aurora to seek out the famed Northern Lights if weather permit. Note: We are unable to guarantee that you will observe the Northern Lights as it is a natural phenomenon and subject to weather conditions.

Day 3 **REYKJAVIK – BLUE LAGOON** (B/Norway Lobster Dinner)

Begin today with a Reykjavik city tour, which starts with Perlan (The Pearl) - a fantastic dome-shaped glass building supported by six massive water tanks, with an impressive water feature that runs from the basement into the atrium. Then, visit the beautiful Höfði House and the Hallgrímskirkja Church where you can view the novel exterior of the Lutheran parish church tower along with the statue of Leifur Eiriksson situated at its front. Next, proceed to the amazing Blue Lagoon geothermal spa (towel provided, please bring swimwear), famous for its healing mineral-rich waters surrounded by jet-black basalt lava

REYKJAVIK - GOLDEN CIRCLE - SELFOSS Day 4 (B/Hotel Dinner)

This morning, proceed to the Thingvellir National Park where the North Atlantic Rift which separates the North American and European continents can be prominently viewed inside the Almannagja Ravine. The world's oldest functioning legislative body, the Icelandic Parliament was also established here. Continue to the stunning two-tiered Gullfoss waterfall, white glacial waters cascading 32m into a 70m deep canyon and considered one of the most beautiful on the island. Drive to the geothermal Great Geysers Area with its many hot springs, mud pools and geysers and witness the spouting of the Strokkur, the world's most active geyser erupting about every eight minutes. This evening, participate in an optional tour to experience the thrill of snowmobiling on a glacier.

*For mid Oct-Mar (Winter) departures -

SELFOSS - SKOGAR - VIK (B/Hotel Dinner) Day 5

Travel through farmlands to the black sand beaches, thundering waterfalls, volcanoes and majestic glaciers of the south coast. Make a stop at Seljalandsfoss where it is possible to walk behind this magnificent wall of water. Continue to the local village and visit the open-air Skogur Folk Museum to learn about the lifestyle of Icelandic people in the past. Enroute, make a stop at the waterfall of Skogur falling gracefully 60m down the green mountain, used more than once as a motif in advertisement

VIK - JOKUSARLON GLACIER LAKE - VIK

(B/Hotel Dinner) After breakfast, proceed to the stunning Jokulsarlon Glacier Lake where breathtaking sights of floating icebergs can be seen. Sail away on a boat cruise in summer (from June to September only) and immerse yourself amist these awe-inspiring and breathtaking structures of nature. Jokulsarlon has also been a setting for popular Hollywood movies such as 'Die Another Day', 'Tomb Raider' and 'Batman Begins'. Continue to Skaftafell National Park-Iceland's second largest national park, with views similar to the Alps formed in thousands of years by different influences of fire, water and rivers. Then, continue to the lava fields of Eldhraun (fire lava) which resulted from a yearlong eruption in 1783 and was referred to as the "misty times" due to the prolonged lingering of the volcanic ash for a prolonged period of time.

Day 7 VIK - HUSAFELL - REYKJAVIK

Today, join an optional tour to the Langjökull glacier-Iceland's second largest glacier. Get onboard a monster truck for a once in a lifetime adventure deep inside one of the world's largest man made ice caverns. The caverns are composed of an extensive system of tunnels and chambers that stretch close to 300 metres into the solid

ice cap towards a breath taking natural ice cave at the heart of the glacier. Afterwards, continue to Reykjavik.

Day 8 **REYKJAVIK**

> Enjoy a free day at leisure, shopping, sightseeing and exploring the city. Alternatively, you may wish to participate in an optional whalewatching to spot some of the Atlantic Oceans's most magnificent mammels. Try to spot the various species including the northern bottlenose whales, minke whales and humpback whales.

Day 9 **REYKJAVIK** → SINGAPORE

Transfer to airport for your flight home.

Day 10 **SINGAPORE**
