SINGAPORE → MELBOURNE

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and begin your holiday with a pleasant flight to Melbourne, the capital of the Australian state of Victoria.

DAY 2

❖ **Queen Victoria Market** – Explore and discover your way through iconic food halls and heritage sheds for fresh local produce, handicrafts, assortment of cooked food, pastries and many more or simply soak up the atmosphere of the largest open-air market in the southern Hemisphere.

Note: If Queen Victoria Market is closed. It will be replaced by South Wharf Direct Factory Outlets (DFO).

❖ **City tour** - begins your city tour by driving pass the **Arts Centre Melbourne** which consists of a complex of theatres and concert halls in the Melbourne Arts Precinct. Next, cross the **Princes Bridge** spanning from the **Yarra River** to the **Federation Square** and see **St Patrick's Cathedral, Flinders Street Station and Chinatown**. See the City Circle Tram in motion along the way and view the **Parliament House, Shrine of Remembrance and Fitzroy Gardens**.

DAY 3

MELBOURNE – PHILIP ISLAND – MELBOURNE

❖ **Panny's Chocolate Factory** - visit Panny's Amazing World of Chocolate and see the educational exhibition on cocoa production, see the two meter chocolate statue of Michelangelo's David, a 12,000 piece chocolate mosaic of Dame Edna Everage. A chocolate village complete with working trains and an amazing spinning Zoetrope. See a giant, one tons block of chocolate, try and lift it with your friends. There is also a thunderous chocolate waterfall, where 400 kilograms of molten chocolate overflows every three minutes.

❖ **Penguin Parade** – Phillip Island is home to the largest Little Penguin colony in the world. You can experience the magic of watching these amazing seabirds waddle home from the ocean to their burrows any night of the year from viewing platforms and boardwalks.

MELBOURNE – GREAT OCEAN ROAD – MELBOURNE

❖ **Great Ocean Road** – experience this breathtaking coastline with pristine beaches, rainforests, charming seaside towns and of course the iconic 12 Apostles.

MELBOURNE – BALLARAT – MELBOURNE

❖ **Sovereign Hill** – one of the best outdoor museums you can experience. With a colourful history relating to the discovery of gold in the region back in the 1850's, Travel the stage coach route of the 1850's along Western Highway to Ballarat, steeped in history with the discovery of gold. Tour through this gracious town with its exquisite gardens, noble statues and magnificent architecture. Pass by the Eureka Stockade, site of the 1854 miner's rebellion.
