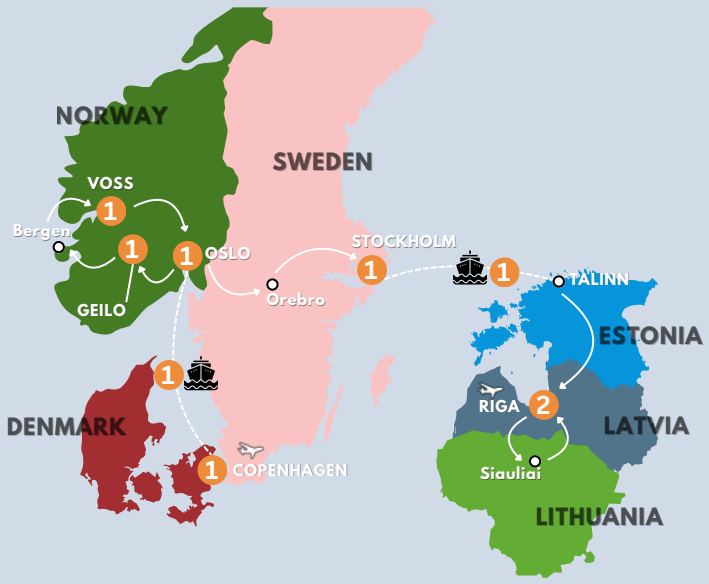

Day 1 SINGAPORE ✈ COPENHAGEN

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to the capital of Denmark - Copenhagen.

Day 2 COPENHAGEN (PORK RIBS D)

Embark on a sightseeing tour to Amalienborg which King's winter residence also famous with the changing of the guards. Then, view the iconic Little Mermaid sculpture by Edvard Eriksen established since 1913 and inspired by the fairy tale of Hans Christian Andersen. Bypass the magnificent Gefion Fountain and drive around the beautiful waterfront of Nyhavn, one of most famous entertainment streets in Copenhagen. Spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure in the shopping precincts of Stroget and the City Hall Square. This evening, check into our hotel in Copenhagen.

Day 3 COPENHAGEN - OVERNIGHT CRUISE - OSLO (B/BUFFET D)

After breakfast, head to Hillerod to explore Frederiksborg Castle (outlook), the largest and most impressive Renaissance structure in northern Europe, dating back to the 16th century. Immerse yourself in the Castle Garden, characterized by its strict symmetrical design featuring terraces, cascades, sculpted trees, and royal monograms. If time allows, you might want to consider visiting the Home of Carlsberg, an engaging attraction situated in the heart of J.C. Jacobsen's original brewery. In the late afternoon, make your way to Copenhagen Pier to embark on an overnight cruise to Oslo, where you can indulge in a lavish Scandinavian seafood buffet dinner served on board.

Day 4 OSLO - GEILO (B/HOTEL D)

Upon your arrival in Norway's capital, Oslo, immerse yourself in the Sculpture Park, featuring 212 life-sized sculptures crafted by Gustav Vigeland, who dedicated his career to this remarkable project. Continue the tour with a photo opportunity at City Hall and The Royal Palace, then proceed to the Holmenkollen Ski Jump Area. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic journey through the beautiful Hallingdal Valley as you make your way to Geilo for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 5 GEILO – BERGEN – VOSS (B/SALMON D)

This morning, travel across the Hardangervidda Plateau to western Norway, to see the most beautiful and classical **Norwegian fjords**. Visit a family-owned **Salmon Farm** to learn more about the Norwegian aquaculture industry. Continue our drive to **Bergen** and upon arrival, immerse in the bustling crowds at the **Fish Market**, continue to UNESCO World Cultural Heritage old wharf site of **Bryggen** and proceed to have funicular ride to **Mount Floien** (320m above sea level) for a panoramic view of Bergen at nightfall.

Day 6 VOSS – OSLO (B/HOTEL D)

Today, you may join an optional to board the breathtaking Flam Railway, which rises from sea level to 3,000 feet, offering stunning views of majestic mountains and cascading waterfalls. After disembarking, you'll transfer to Sognefjord, Norway's longest and deepest fjord. We will set sail on a picturesque **cruise**, taking in the beautiful sights before we disembark and drive to Hemsedal, with a quick photo stop at the renowned **Borgund Stave Church**. Finally, we'll return to our hotel in Oslo, home to the world's most impressive indoor arena for snow activities.

Day 7 OSLO – OREBRO – STOCKHOLM (B/LOCAL L/MEATBALLS D)

After breakfast, we will cross the border into Sweden. Our first stop will be **Örebro**, which translates to "bridge over the gravel banks," a city established as early as the 13th century. Here, we will explore **Örebro Castle** (outlook), a historic site that has stood for over seven hundred years, and is still home to the current governor today. We will then continue our journey to Sweden's capital, Stockholm, where we will spend the night. Don't miss the chance to indulge in the local specialty – **Swedish meatballs**.

Day 8 STOCKHOLM – OVERNIGHT CRUISE – TALLINN (B/BUFFET D)

Set off on a sightseeing adventure that begins at **City Hall**, the esteemed location of the Nobel Prize banquets. Next, enjoy a leisurely walk through the charming **Gamla Stan (Old Town)**, which dates back to the 16th to 18th centuries, and then pass by **The Royal Palace**. In the afternoon, you may want to join an optional excursion to The Vasa Museum in Stockholm, where you'll discover the stories of the courageous seafarers and raids from the Viking Age, as well as the lives of the women, children, and men who lived on the farms. Afterward, head to the pier for an overnight cruise to Tallinn.

Day 9 TALLINN – RIGA (B/PORK KNUCKLE & BEER L)

This morning, embark on a journey to the Estonian capital, **Tallinn**. Begin tour at **Toompea Hill**, which provides breathtaking views of the city and is home to the famous **Alexander Nevsky Cathedral**. This Russian Orthodox cathedral is renowned for its intricate domes and stunning mosaics. Take a short walk to the **Kohtuotsa Viewing Platform**, where you can admire panoramic vistas of the city's red-tiled roofs, church spires, and the Baltic Sea. Wander through **Tallinn's Old Town**, a UNESCO World Heritage site, featuring charming medieval architecture and rich history. Finally, indulge in the local cuisine by savoring pork knuckle paired with beer. Next, transfer to **Riga** for our overnight stay.

Day 10 RIGA – SIAULIAI - RIGA (B/LOCAL L)

This morning, head to **Riga Central Market**, one of the largest marketplaces in Eastern Europe and a top destination in Riga. Next, cross the border into **Lithuania** to visit the **Hill of Crosses**. This hill is adorned with an astonishing number of crosses, which have accumulated over the years into the tens of thousands, serving as a powerful symbol of faith. After lunch, return to **Riga** and enjoy a walking tour of the old town, which is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore two of the city's most impressive landmarks: the **Dome Church** and **St. Peter's Church**. From the observation deck of the 72-meter-high tower, you can enjoy a breathtaking panorama of Riga (entry at your own expense). Make sure to stop for a photo at Riga's top attraction, **The House of the Blackheads**. Finally, visit the **Black Magic Cafe**, which is linked to the ancient tale of the origin of "Riga Black Balsam" and its creator, the alchemist and pharmacist Abraham Kuncce.

Day 11 RIGA ✈ SINGAPORE (B)

After breakfast, spend the free at leisure till departure transfer to airport for your flight back to Singapore.

Day 1 新加坡 ✈️ 哥本哈根

集于新加坡樟宜机场，乘搭豪华客机飞往丹麦首都-哥本哈根，展开多姿多彩的北欧之旅。

Day 2 哥本哈根 (猪肋排晚餐)

游览**阿美琳堡宫**，这里是国王的冬季住所，也因皇家卫队的换岗仪式而闻名。接着，参观由埃德瓦尔德·埃里克森于1913年建立的标志性“小美人鱼”雕像，灵感来源于汉斯·克里斯蒂安·安徒生的童话故事。经过宏伟的**格菲昂喷泉**，并沿着美丽的**新港**，这是哥本哈根最著名的娱乐街之一。下午时间可在**斯楚尔街**和**市政厅广场**购物区自由活动。今晚，我们将入住哥本哈根酒店。

Day 3 哥本哈根 - 邮轮 - 奥斯陆 (早/自助晚餐)

早餐后，前往参观**腓特烈堡城堡**（外观），这是北欧最大、最令人印象深刻的文艺复兴建筑，建于16世纪。沉浸在严格对称设计的**城堡花园**中，这里有露台、瀑布、修剪整齐的树木和皇家字母组合。如果时间允许，您还可以考虑参观**卡尔斯伯格之家**，这是一处位于J.C.雅各布森原酿酒厂中心的精彩景点。下午，前往哥本哈根码头，登上前往奥斯陆的夜间邮轮，在船上享用丰盛的**斯堪的纳维亚海鲜自助晚餐**。

Day 4 奥斯陆 - 盖罗 (早/酒店晚餐)

抵达挪威首都**奥斯陆**，参观在**雕塑公园**，这里展出了由古斯塔夫·维根兰德创作的212座真人大小的雕塑，他将自己的职业生涯献给了这一杰出项目。继续游览并在**市政厅**和**皇宫**拍照留念，然后前往**霍尔门科伦滑雪跳台**目睹现有先进的冬季运动设备。午时，沿着景色优美的**Hallingdal**滑雪度假村于盖罗入住一晚。

Day 5 盖罗 - 步尔根 - 沃斯 (早/三文鱼晚餐)

今早，穿越哈当厄维达高原前往挪威西部，欣赏美丽和经典的挪威峡湾。途中参观一家家族经营的**三文鱼养殖场**，可以了解更多关于挪威水产养殖业的信息。继续驱车前往**卑尔根**，抵达后，游览当地**鱼市场**，随后前往联合国教科文组织世界文化遗产的**布吕根老码头**，继续乘坐缆车前往**弗洛伊恩山**（海拔320米），在黄昏时分俯瞰卑尔根的全景。

Day 6 沃斯 - 奥斯陆 (早/酒店晚餐)

今天，可以选择自费乘坐令人叹为观止的**弗拉姆铁路**，铁路从海平面升至3000英尺，沿途可欣赏到雄伟的山脉和倾泻而下的瀑布。下车后，转乘游船前往**松恩峡湾**，这是挪威最长且最深的峡湾。乘坐风景如画的**游船**，欣赏美丽的景色，随后下船并驱车前往著名的**博伦德木教堂**稍作停留拍照。最后，我们将返回奥斯陆的酒店，那里有世界上最令人印象深刻的室内雪上活动场馆*。

Day 7 奥斯陆 - 厄勒布鲁 - 斯德哥尔摩 (早/午餐/瑞典肉丸晚餐)

早餐后，我们将跨越边境进入瑞典。我们的第一站将是厄勒布鲁，意为“砾石堤上的桥”，这座城市早在13世纪就已建立。在这里，我们将参观已有七百多年历史的**厄勒布鲁城堡**（外观），今天仍是现任总督的官邸。之后，我们将继续前往瑞典首都**斯德哥尔摩**，并过夜。不容错过品尝当地特色菜——**瑞典肉丸**的机会。

Day 8 斯德哥尔摩 - 邮轮 - 塔林 (早/自助晚餐)

开启今天观光路线，首先参观**市政厅**，这里是诺贝尔奖宴会的举办地。接着，悠闲漫步于迷人的**老城 (Gamla Stan)**，这里可追溯到16至18世纪，随后途经**皇宫**。下午，自费前往**斯德哥尔摩的瓦萨博物馆 (Vasa Museum)**，在那里探索勇敢的航海者和维京时代的袭击故事，了解当时农场上妇女、儿童的生活。之后，前往码头，乘坐过夜游轮前往**塔林**。

Day 9 塔林 - 里加 (早/猪肘与啤酒午餐)

今早，前往爱沙尼亚首都**塔林**。游览从**图姆佩亚山**开始，这里可以俯瞰全城，享受绝美的城市景观，同时也是著名的**亚历山大·涅夫斯基大教堂**的所在地。这座俄罗斯东正教大教堂以其精美的圆顶和华丽的马赛克而闻名。步行至**科赫图欧察观景台**，从这里可以欣赏到城市红色屋顶、教堂尖塔和波罗的海的全景。漫步于**塔林老城**，是联合国教科文组织世界遗产地，拥有迷人的中世纪建筑和丰富的历史。最后，品尝当地美食，享用啤酒搭配猪肘的美味佳肴。接着，送往**里加**入住过夜酒店。

Day 10 里加 - 希奥利艾 - 里加 (早餐/午餐)

今早，前往**里加中央市场**，这是东欧最大的市场之一，也是里加最热门目的地。接下来，跨越边境前往**立陶宛**参观**十字架山**。这山上矗立着数以万计的十字架，随着时间的推移逐渐累积，成为信仰的强大象征。午餐后，返回里加。享受老城区的徒步游览，该城区也同时被列为联合国教科文组织世界遗产。探索城市中最具代表性的两大地标：**里加大教堂**和**圣彼得教堂**。从72米高的塔楼观景台（自理），可以欣赏到里加的壮丽全景。别忘了在里加的热门景点“**黑头宫**”停留拍照。最后，参观**黑魔法咖啡馆**，这里与“里加黑药酒”的起源故事以及其创始人、炼金术士兼药剂师**亚伯拉罕·昆策**的传奇息息相关。

Day 11 里加 ✈️ 新加坡 (早餐)

早餐后，自由活动，然后前往机场乘机返回新加坡。

Day 12 新加坡

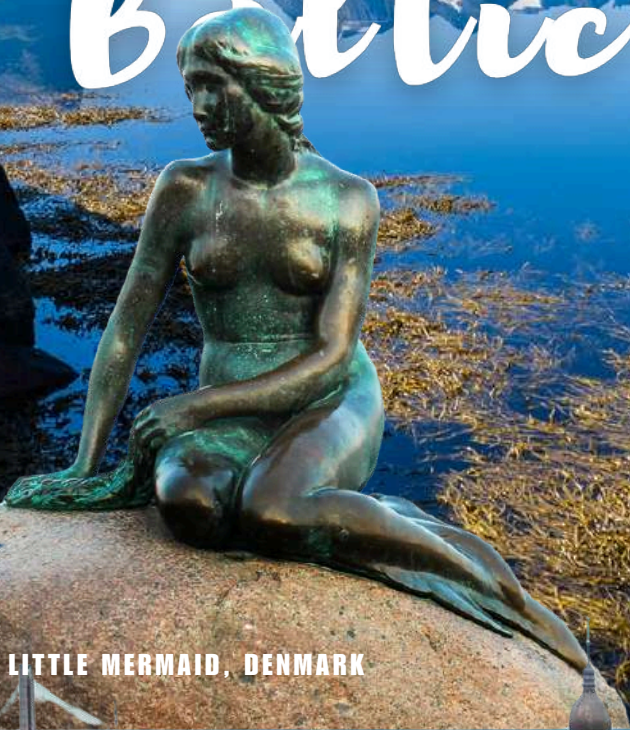
