Day 1 SINGAPORE X ALMATY

Your journey starts with a flight to Almaty, which includes a brief layover in Kuala Lumpur/Guangzhou/Beijing. Once you arrive, you will be greeted by our guide and proceed to hotel for the night.

Day 2 ALMATY - CHARYN CANYONS -ALMATY (B/L/D)

Today, embark on an exciting full-day excursion to the breathtaking Charyn Canyon, regarded as one of Kazakhstan's most remarkable natural treasures. Over the course of 12 million years, the canyon has been sculpted by the elements, resulting in towering cliffs that resemble ancient stone castles. As journey, you'll receive captivating insights into the region's history, Kazakh culture, and local traditions, with a delightful lunch break that offers a taste of authenticity. Prepare to be awestruck; the stunning beauty of Charyn Canyon is sure to leave you speechless. Take in the panoramic vistas, and then meander through the enchanting Valley of Castles, surrounded by dramatic rock formations and soaring cliffs.

Day 3 ALMATY (B/L/HORSE MEAT D)

Begin your journey at Medeo Gorge, renowned for hosting the world's highest mountain skating rink and a substantial dam that protects the city from mudflows. Next, make our way to Shymbulak Ski Resort, where you can enjoy breathtaking vistas from 2,230 meters above sea level. Afterward, return to the city to explore **Republic Square**, the **Independence Monument**, and the **Abay Opera House**. Immerse yourself in the lively ambiance of the Green Bazaar, then relax in the tranquil Park of 28 Panfilov Guardsmen, taking in the stunning **Zenkov's Cathedral**. Conclude your day atop Kok-Tobe Hill, where you can revel in a spectacular panoramic view of Almaty, followed by a ride down the famous cableway.

Day 4 ALMATY - ISSYK KUL (B/L/D)

Today, embark to the Kazakh-Kyrgyz border for customs clearance as we enter Kyrgyzstan. Begin your drive toward Burana Tower, leading you to the quaint town of Tokmok, where you can explore the ruins of an ancient city and ascend the 11th-century minaret for breathtaking panoramic views. Conclude a scenic drive through the magnificent Tian-Shan Mountain Range, heading toward Issyk Kul.



Dav 5 ISSYK KUL - CHONG-KEMIN VALLEY - ISSYK KUL (B/L/D)

Embark on a morning drive to a charming mountain village, where tradition meets serenity. Along the way, make a photo stop at **Boom Gorge**, the natural connector between the Chui Valley and Issyk-Kul Lake. Carved by the mighty Chu River and the gorge showcases striking contrasts: verdant, wooded slopes transition into arid clay canyons. Next, enjoy a mesmerizing eagle show featuring the Berkut, the esteemed golden eagle of Kyrgyz culture. This hour-long display of ancient eagle hunting traditions is truly captivating. Continue our journey through the **Chong-Kemin Valley**, a pristine national park characterized by its rugged mountains and lush pastures. Travel back Issyk Kul for overnight stay.

Day 6 ISSYK KUL - BISHKEK (B/L/CHINESE D)

This morning, set off toward the capital of Kyrgyzstan -**Bishkek**. Upon arrival, indulge in some local cuisine for lunch before embarking on a city tour. Your first stop will be the Turkish Mosque. Next, visit Victory Square, where you can appreciate the historical importance of this landmark. Then, explore the Central Square, featuring the impressive Manas **Statue**. Immerse yourself in the rich cultural heritage at the Historical Museum. Conclude your day at the Old Square, where you can admire the iconic **Lenin Statue**.

Day 7 BISHKEK 🛪 TASHKENT (B/L/MANTI & SAMSA D)

After breakfast, head to the airport for your flight to **Tashkent**. Upon arrival, start the city tour at **Independence Square**, a symbol of peace and victory from World War II. Walk along Broadway, a lively street connecting **Independence Square** to **Amir Timur Square**. Enjoy a short ride on the Tashkent Metro, known for its stunning architecture since 1977. Then, visit the old city to explore Chorsu Bazaar, Kukaldash Madrasah, and the Hast Imam **Complex**, home to ancient structures. Don't miss the **Othman** Quran, the oldest known Quran from the 8th century. This evening, indulge in a flavorful local dinner soaking in the vibrant atmosphere of the Uzbek capital. It's the perfect way to unwind and savor the rich culture of Tashkent

Day 8 TASHKENT = SAMARKAND (B/L/KEBAB D)

This morning, embark on a high-speed train journey to **Samarkand**. Immerse yourself in a day filled with culture and Instagram-worthy moments! Begin your adventure at the **Gur-**Amir Mausoleum and Shakhi-Zinda Necropolis, where you can capture stunning architectural masterpieces. Take a leisurely stroll through Registan Square and be mesmerized by the heart of ancient Samarkand, featuring its magnificent madrasahs. Next, wander through the vibrant **Syob Bazaar**, an explosion of sights, sounds, and scents, perfect for selecting local treasures as keepsakes or gifts.

Day 9 SAMARKAND (B)

Today, you have free time to relax, or you can opt to join a tour to the stunning Seven Lakes in Tajikistan. This hidden gem, situated in the Fan Mountains, lies along the gorge of the Shing River. Each of these pristine lakes features a distinct, captivating color, forming a breathtaking natural masterpiece.

Day 10 samarkand 🚞 BUKHARA (B/L/ARABIAN NIGHT D)

Highlights include the exquisite Ismail Samani Mausoleum and the revered Chashma Ayub Mausoleum, as well as the Kukeldash Madrassah, the largest Koran school in Central Asia. Enjoy the local atmosphere and capture great photos at tonight's restaurant.

Today, you will set off on a picturesque 450km journey to Khiva. This drive is adorned with charming villages and expansive cotton fields throughout the route. Once arrive, enjoy dinner and check in to your hotel for a delightful overnight stay.
