MADRID Day 2

(Tapas Dinner)

Upon arrival, visit Museo Torino, the bullfighting museum opened since 1931 that also features the bullring once held for bullfighting races. Afterwards, continue to the Cervantes Monument in Plaza Espana, Puerta del Sol, Gran Via and Madrid most famous fountain - the Cibeles Fountain. After dinner, enjoy a panoramic view of the city over the Tagus River and check-in to hotel for a well-deserved rest.

Day 3 MADRID

(Breakfast) Today is free at leisure for you to explore Madrid on your own. Alternatively, you may consider to participate in an optional tour to Toledo, the former capital of medieval Spain including a visit to the 13th century Gothic Cathedral where we will see EL Greco masterpieces of Santo Tome. Afterwards, return to Madrid and proceed to Las Rozas Village Outlet for a shop till you drop

(B, Suckling Pig Lunch) After breakfast, head on to Segovia for excellent photo opportunities of the 2000 years old Roman Aqueduct which runs through the city. Be treated to a very authentic lunch as we savour the famous succulent roast suckling pig lunch. Continue to the golden city of Salamanca and see the handsome arcaded Plaza Mayor, Salamanca University and The Cathedral.

SALAMANCA - FATIMA (Portugal) - LISBON (B/Seafood D) Dav 5 This morning, we'll drive across the Portuguese border to reach Fatima for a visit to the Shrine of Fatima, which commemorates the miraculous appearance of the Virgin Mary to three children in 1917. Photo stop at The Chapel Of Apparitions and Berlin Wall Monument. Then, we leave the Serra d'Aire Mountains for Lisbon, the capital of Portugal.

Day 6 LISBON

(B,Tea Break)

Today, begin your Lisbon sightseeing with photo stops to the Monuments of Discoveries and the Belem Tower. Then, continue to Jeronimo's Monastery and Don't miss the Portuguese traditional pastry 'Custard Tarts'. You may want to take an optional excursion to the little charming fishing village of Cascais , Sintra and the most western point of continental Europe Cabo Da Roca.

DAY 7 LISBON - SEVILLE (Spain) Day 7

(B, Hotel Buffet D)

This morning, we will cross the border back to Spain and continue to the capital of Andalusia region - Seville, site of the 1992 World Expo. The city was influenced by the Moors who dwelt in this area for 700 years. View Plaza De Espana, one of the most beautiful building at Seville, the 15th century gothic Cathedral, burial place of Christopher Columbus and the Giralda Tower, gem of Islamic art.

SEVILLE – GRANADA Day 8

(B, Hotel Buffet D) After breakfast, travel inland to Granada, capital of the Moorish Kingdom of Spain until the Moor's defeat in 1942 and view the Alhambra Palace and Water Garden Of Generalife. You may consider to participate in an optional tour to Mijas-a typically Andulasian white-washed village located at a mountain side about 450m above sea level, in the heart of the costa del sol region.

GRANADA – GUADIX – VALENCIA (B, Seafood Paella Dinner) Dav 9

Drive over Mora Pass and enjoy the view of Sierra Nevada. The town of Guadix has very interesting feature as almost half of the inhabitants live in cave houses. Visit the Cave Museum Immaculate, a cultural and educational visit in purullena located in one of the main sites of cave houses of Guadix region. Continue travel to Valencia, the third largest city in Spain and pass the Tower Of Serrano and Cuarte and the Arts and Sciences. Continue to famous landmark La Lonja de la Seda, a Gothic-style building that was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. If time allows, experience the hustle and bustle of Mercado Central. This huge iron, glass and tiled Art Nouveau building opened in 1928 and is one of the largest and most attractive markets in Europe. Tonight, savour Spain Seafood Paella Dinner.

Day 10 VALENCIA - BARCELONA

This morning, enjoy a leisure drive heading towards Barcelona and upon arrival proceed to the Gothic Quarter and marvel at the middle age buildings that enhance the city's uniqueness. Head to Montjuic Hill for a panoramic view of the city and tour the mordern Eixample District and view Guadi famed Sagrada Familia Church. Later, enjoy exploring Las Ramblas- lively pedestrian promenade stretching from Plaza Catalonia to the harbour where you can get branded items such as Loewe, Chanel, Gucci, etc.

BARCELONA **Day 11**

Today is free at leisure for you to explore Barcelona on your own. Alternatively, you may consider to participate in an optional tour to Montserrat, a beautiful multi-peak mountain with dramatic rock formations and later visit La Roca Village for the Chic Outlet Shopping, where you will find past season collections from the world's leading Spanish and international luxury fashion and lifestyle brands.
