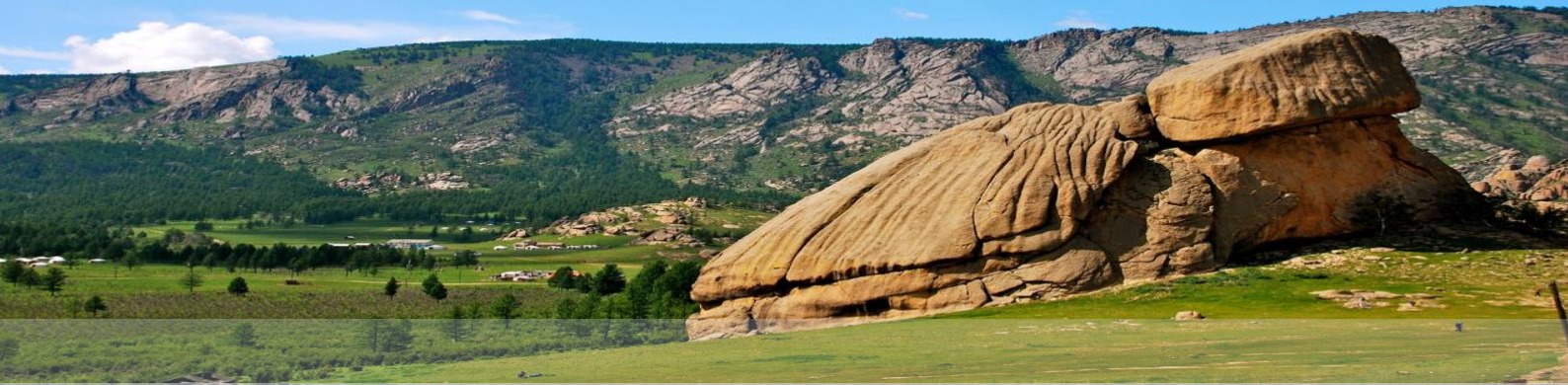

DAY 1

SINGAPORE → ULAANBAATAR – TRADITIONAL FOLK CONCERT (MOB/DINNER – BBQ)

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to the **Land of Blue Sky – Mongolia**. Upon arriving to the capital of Mongolia, Ulaanbaatar, you will get to enjoy **Traditional Folk Concert** to mark the start of your trip in Mongolia.

DAY 2

ULAANBAATAR – MONGOL NOMADIC SHOW (DURATION: 2 HOURS) – KHUSTAI NATIONAL PARK – ELSEN TASARKHAI – CAMEL RIDING (BREAKFAST/LUNCH/DINNER)

We will be watching the **Mongol Nomadic Show** that introduces and demonstrates the everyday lifestyle of the Nomadic people. After the show ends, proceed to **Khustai National Park**, where animals roam freely in their protected natural habitat. The National Park also serves as the home to the once extinct Przewalski Horses, Gazelle, Red Deer and many other animals. Stop for an authentic lunch at a suitable spot along the way. Later, **visit a local nomad family** where you will have an opportunity to experience their way of life, their culture and traditions. Take a look at how some Mongolians are still keeping their traditional lifestyles. Next stop is **Elsen Tasarkhai** known as Semi-Gobi because of its resemblance to the famous Gobi Desert that stretches for 80km. Immerse yourself in the stunning landscape. that hundreds of birds, deer, and gazelle that call this mountain home. Settle at the tourist Ger Camp located next to the dunes. Embark on a **Camel Ride** among the dunes and enjoy the magnificent view of the Sunset.



DAY 3

KHARKHORIN TOWN – ERDENEZUU MONASTERY – KHARKHORIM MUSEUM – ORKHON VALLEY (BREAKFAST/LUNCH/DINNER)

After breakfast, proceed to the **Ancient Capital of Great Mongol Empire, Kharkhorin City – Erdenezuu Monastery** was founded in 1586 and it is the first Buddhist monastery in Mongolia. It is enlisted in the UNESCO World Heritage list as the part of the 'Orkhon Valley Cultural Landscape'. Afterwards, proceed to **Kharkhorim Museum** – is named after the ancient capital, Kharkhorim City (the capital of Mongolia, during 13th century). The Museum holds artifacts belong to Stone Age, Bronze Age, and findings from four empires that once roamed the surrounding **Orkhon Valley**, including precious artefacts from the Great Mongol Empire times.

DAY 4

ULAANBAATAR (BREAKFAST/LUNCH/DINNER)

On this day, we will be travelling back to **Ulaanbaatar**. On the way to Ulaanbaatar, we will be able to spot some scenic view while heading back to Ulaanbaatar.

DAY 5

TERELJ NATIONAL PARK – TURTLE ROCK – ARYAPALA MEDITATION TEMPLE – HORSEBACK RIDING VISIT NOMADIC FAMILY (BREAKFAST/LUNCH/DINNER)

Terelj National Park is located 80km northeast of Ulaanbaatar City, the park is often visited for its beautiful scenery including unique rock formations like the **Melhi Khad** – Also known as the **Turtle Rock**, is one of the most popular rock formations located at Terelj National Park. It is a 24 meters high rock that has a distinct turtle shape. Next, take a small hike to visit the **Aryabal Mediation Temple** located at the mountainside in Terelj National Park and offers a breathtaking view of the Park. Proceed to visit the Nomadic Family and embark on **Horseback Riding**.

DAY 6

CHINGGIS KHAN STATUE COMPLEX – ULAANBAATAR – BOGD KHAN PALACE MUSEUM – GOBI CASHMERE FACTORY STORE – STATE DEPARTMENT STORE (BREAKFAST/LUNCH/DINNER)

After breakfast, drive to **Chinggis Khan Statue complex** – Also known as the Tsonjin Boldog is currently known as the biggest equestrian statue in the world. It is 40 meters tall and wrapped in 250tons of stainless steel. The complex was built in 2008 for the occasion of 800th anniversary of the foundation of the Great Mongolian Empire. Next, we will drive back to Ulaanbaatar City to discover the hidden gems – **Bogd Khan Palace Museum**, this palace was built between 1893 and 1903, where Mongolia's eighth Living Buddha, Bogd Khan lived for 20 years. The palace was spared destruction by the Russians and turned into a museum. You may enjoy your last minute shopping at Gobi Cashmere Factory Store and State Department Store.

DAY 7
